

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 66 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

3 An Ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
4 Estimate and Apportionment authorizing a “Fifth Supplemental Appropriation” in an aggregate
5 amount not to exceed Forty Million Six Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$40,675,000)
6 from appropriately designated “Series __ Commercial Paper Construction Account” of the
7 “Commercial Paper Construction Fund” established under the Commercial Paper Subordinate
8 Indenture of Trust dated May 1, 2004 and authorized pursuant to Ordinance 66232 approved March
9 30, 2004 (the “CP Note Ordinance 66232”), into the W-1W Expansion Program Ordinance 64279
10 approved March 9, 1998, as amended by Ordinance 64598 approved February 18, 1999, Ordinance
11 65149 approved February 8, 2001, Ordinance 65501 approved May 14, 2002, and Ordinance 66489
12 approved November 17, 2004, which authorized and established a multi-year public work and
13 improvement program (the “W-1W Expansion Program”) at Lambert-St. Louis International
14 Airport® that is more fully described in Section One of Ordinance 64279 as amended, in order to
15 continue the W-1W Expansion Program and the payment or reimbursement of eligible W-1W
16 Expansion Program costs authorized therein; authorizing and directing the Mayor, Comptroller,
17 Treasurer, City Counselor, Register of St. Louis, and/or other appropriate City officials as necessary
18 to make such applications or certifications and provide such data to the Note Trustee, Note
19 Registrar, and/or Payment Agent for the “Commercial Paper Notes” (as defined and authorized
20 under the CP Note Ordinance 66232), and to take whatever action necessary in order to provide for
21 the payment or reimbursement of eligible W-1W Expansion Program costs authorized therein;
22 conditioning the appropriation from the Commercial Paper Construction Fund and the expenditure

1 or reimbursement of funds authorized herein on the issuance in one or more series of Commercial
2 Paper Notes; containing a severability clause; and an emergency clause.

3 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

4 **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby authorized a “Fifth Supplemental Appropriation” in an
5 aggregate amount not to exceed Forty Million Six Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars
6 (\$40,675,000) from the appropriately designated ”Series __ Commercial Paper Construction
7 Account” of the “Commercial Paper Construction Fund” established under the Commercial Paper
8 Subordinate Indenture of Trust dated May 1, 2004 and authorized pursuant to Ordinance 66232
9 approved March 30, 2004 (the “CP Note Ordinance 66232”), into the W-1W Expansion Program
10 Ordinance 64279 approved March 9, 1998, as amended by Ordinance 64598 approved February 18,
11 1999, Ordinance 65149 approved February 8, 2001, Ordinance 65501 approved May 14, 2002, and
12 Ordinance 66489 approved November 17, 2004, which authorized and established a multi-year
13 public work and improvement program (the “W-1W Expansion Program”) at Lambert-St. Louis
14 International Airport® that is more fully described in Section One of Ordinance 64279 as amended,
15 in order to continue the W-1W Expansion Program and the payment or reimbursement of eligible
16 W-1W Expansion Program costs authorized therein.

17 **SECTION TWO.** The Mayor, Comptroller, Treasurer, City Counselor, the Register,
18 and/or other appropriate officials of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), as necessary, are hereby
19 authorized and directed to make such applications or certifications and provide such data to the Note
20 Trustee, Note Registrar, and/or Payment Agent for the “Commercial Paper Notes” (as defined and
21 authorized under the CP Note Ordinance 66232), and to take whatever action necessary in order to

1 provide for the payment or reimbursement of eligible W-1W Expansion Program costs authorized
2 therein.

3 **SECTION THREE.** This Fifth Supplemental Appropriation from the Commercial
4 Paper Construction Fund and the expenditure or reimbursement of funds authorized herein is
5 expressly conditioned on the issuance in one or more series of Commercial Paper Notes.

6 **SECTION FOUR.** The sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance or portions
7 thereof shall be severable. If any section, condition, or provision of this Ordinance or portion thereof
8 is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining
9 sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance.

10 **SECTION FIVE.** This being an Ordinance providing for a public works and improvement
11 program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20, of
12 the City’s Charter and shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor of the City.
