

**BOARD BILL NO. 101 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY,
ALDERMAN JOSEPH VACCARO**

1 An Ordinance recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment authorizing and
2 directing the Director of Airports and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the "City") to enter
3 into and execute on behalf of the City the "First Amendment To Lease Agreement" (the "First
4 Amendment") to the Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® Lease Agreement AL-542 between
5 the City and Airport Terminal Services, Inc., commencing November 1, 2008, and authorized by
6 City Ordinance No. 68117, approved October 6, 2008 (the "Agreement"); the First Amendment,
7 which is attached hereto as **ATTACHMENT "1"** and made a part hereof, was approved by the
8 City's Airport Commission, and its terms are more fully described in Section One of this Ordinance;
9 containing a severability clause; and containing an emergency clause.

10 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

11 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Airports and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the
12 "City") are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City the "First
13 Amendment To Lease Agreement" (the "First Amendment") to the Lambert-St. Louis International
14 Airport® Lease Agreement AL-542 between the City and Airport Terminal Services, Inc.,
15 commencing November 1, 2008, and authorized by City Ordinance No. 68117, approved October 6,
16 2008 (the "Agreement"); the First Amendment was approved by the City's Airport Commission and
17 is to read in words and figures substantially as set out in **ATTACHMENT "1"**, which is attached
18 hereto and made a part hereof.

19 **SECTION TWO.** The sections, conditions, and provisions of this Ordinance or portions

1 thereof shall be severable. If any section, condition, or provision of this Ordinance or portion thereof
2 is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining
3 sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance.

4 **SECTION THREE.** This being an Ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health,
5 or safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20 of
6 the City's Charter and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the
7 City.
