

BOARD BILL NO. 102 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MATT VILLA

1 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Board of Public Service to let contracts,
2 purchase materials, equipment and supplies, employ labor, hire consultants, pay fees, salaries
3 and wages or otherwise provide for the improvement of the Howard Bend and Chain of Rocks
4 water treatment plants, estimated to cost Twelve Million Five Hundred Thousand (\$12,500,000);
5 appropriating funds from the proceeds of the sale of the St. Louis Water Revenue Bonds, Series
6 2010, contingent upon the sale of said bonds; containing sections for description of the work,
7 approval of plans and specifications, work and material guarantees, applicable state and federal
8 wage rate requirements, equal opportunity provisions, the Mayor's Executive Orders, contract
9 advertising statutes and a public work emergency clause.

10 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS**
11 **FOLLOWS:**

12 **Section 1.** The Board of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to let
13 contracts, purchase materials, equipment and supplies, employ and pay for labor, consultants,
14 employees, supervision, wages and fringe benefits, pay fees, salaries and otherwise provide for
15 improvement of the Howard Bend and Chain of Rocks water treatment plants, in accordance
16 with plans and specification approved and adopted by said Board of Public Service.

17 **Section 2.** The work provided herein shall be carried out in accordance with detailed
18 plans and specifications to be adopted and approved by the Board of Public Service before bids
19 are advertized therefore.

20 **Section 3.** Any contract, or contracts, shall provide that the contractor, or contractors,
21 doing said work shall guarantee and keep in good repair all of the work and materials used in

1 connection therewith for a term of at least one year commencing on the date of acceptance of the
2 work by the City.

3 **Section 4.** The sum of Twelve Million Five Hundred Thousand (\$12,500,000) is
4 hereby appropriated from the proceeds of the sale of the St. Louis Water Revenue Bonds, Series
5 2010, contingent upon the sale of said bonds, to pay the estimated costs of the City as authorized
6 herein.

7 **Section 5.** All construction contracts let under authority of this Ordinance shall
8 provide that no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages in the City of St. Louis, as
9 determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri (Section
10 290.210 through 290.340 RSMo, as amended) pay for legal holidays and overtime work shall be
11 paid to all workers. All contracts let in connection with the construction provided for herein shall
12 be subject to, and in conformance with, all statutes of the State of Missouri and the Charter and
13 Code of the City of St. Louis.

14 **Section 6.** The Comptroller of the City of St. Louis shall be and is hereby directed to
15 draw warrants from time to time on the Treasurer of said City for the several payments of the
16 costs specified in Section One (1) hereof.

17 **Section 7.** All specifications approved by the Board of Public Service and contracts
18 let under authority of this Ordinance shall provide for compliance with the Mayor's Executive
19 Orders on Equal Opportunity dated March 25, 1982 and December 6, 1984, and the Mayor's
20 Executive Order of December 22, 1986 on selection of experts and consultants.

21 **Section 8.** All advertisement for bids pursuant to this Ordinance shall be subject to
22 Section 8.250, RSMo, as amended.

1 **Section 9.** This being an Ordinance providing for public work, or improvements, an
2 emergency is hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Sections Nineteen (19) and Twenty
3 (20) of Article Four of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall become effective
4 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
