INTRODUCED BY ALDERMEN CRAIG SCHMID AND

1 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Civil Service Commission pertaining to
2 employee benefits, amending Section Twenty-Two of Ordinance 66272 by authorizing the City
3 Health Benefits Committee to develop and approve programs for life, health, medical, disability,
4 and other insurance coverage deemed necessary for employees in the Classified Service and
5 other employees for the City and their dependents; further authoring the Director of Personnel to
6 administer such programs.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8 SECTION ONE. Section Twenty-two of Ordinance 66272 is hereby amended to read as
9 follows:

10 Section Twenty-two. The City of St. Louis is hereby authorized to devise and
11 establish by contract or otherwise plans for life, health, medical, disability, and other insurance
12 coverage deemed necessary for employees in the Classified Service and other employees for the
13 City and their dependents. The City Health Benefits Committee shall develop and approve
14 programs for such coverage. The Director of Personnel shall administer such programs approved
15 by the City Health Benefits Committee. The Director of Personnel shall confer with the Board
16 of Estimate and Apportionment by February 1st of each year regarding these plans and the
17 appropriate funding level. The Director shall then be charged with the responsibility of
18 establishing the applicable funding level and remittance rates for the aforementioned plans and
19 certify same to the Comptroller and Budget Director by March 1st of each year and no officer or
20 employee shall alter or amend such rates.
