

1 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying the
2 actions of the Mayor of the City of St. Louis, in submitting, on behalf of the City, a Substantial
3 Amendment to the 2008 Consolidated Plan to the United States Department of Housing and Urban
4 Development ("HUD") as required to apply for funding under the Federal American Recovery and
5 Reinvestment Act ("ARRA") Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG-R"),
6 authorizing and directing the Mayor and the Comptroller on behalf of the City to enter into and
7 execute agreements with HUD for the receipt of 2008 CDBG-R funds, appropriating the sum of Five
8 Million Three Hundred Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Forty Eight Dollars (\$5,333,348)
9 which additional amount the City has been allocated for the 2008 Program Year, authorizing and
10 directing the Director of the Community Development Administration ("CDA") to contract with
11 municipal agencies, non-profit corporations and other entities, as necessary for the expenditure of
12 CDBG-R funds, and directing the Comptroller to issue warrants thereon upon the City Treasury; and
13 containing an emergency clause.

14 WHEREAS, the City received a notice on May 6, 2009, that 2008 CDBG-R funding ARRA
15 would be available to the City and that in order to receive these funds the City was required to
16 submit to HUD a Substantial Amendment to its 2008 Consolidated Plan no later than June 5, 2009;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, following the passage of Resolution #57 by the St. .Louis Board of Aldermen
19 listing projects to be funded with CDBG-R and approving such projects for submission to HUD for
20 CDBG-R funding, the Mayor of the City of St. Louis, on behalf of the City, submitted to HUD the
21 required Substantial Amendment to the 2008 Consolidated Plan on June 5, 2009, and

1 WHEREAS, the 2008 CDBG-R Entitlement is Five Million Three Hundred Thirty-Three
2 Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$5,333,348); and

3 WHEREAS, the City has identified certain known appropriation needs as summarized in
4 Exhibit A, and the City desires to appropriate the CDBG-R Entitlement Funds for these needs.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section One. The July 5, 2009, submission to the Department of Housing and Urban
7 Development of a Substantial Amendment to the City's 2008 Consolidated Plan in order to make
8 application for the 2008 CDBG-R Entitlement Program by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis, acting
9 on behalf of the City, is hereby ratified. .

10 Section Two. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Five Million Three Hundred Thirty-
11 Three Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$5,333,348) of CDBG-R funds for the
12 purposes described in Exhibit A incorporated herein by reference. The Director of CDA is hereby
13 authorized to make, negotiate and execute any and all contracts or other documents, including
14 disbursing agreements and/or other agreements, on behalf of the City, which are necessary to carry
15 out the City's CDBG-R program and to expend said funds for the purposes and in the amounts
16 specified in Exhibit A attached hereto, and the Comptroller is authorized and directed to issue
17 warrants upon the City Treasury for payment thereon.

18 Section Three. This being an ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the
19 public peace, health and safety and making appropriations for the payment of principal and
20 interest on public debt and for the current expenses of the City government, an emergency is
21 hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Section 20, Article IV, of the Charter and this
22 ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the
23 Mayor.
