

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 134 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN CONWAY**

2 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a
3 supplemental appropriation; amending Ordinance 67090, commonly referred to as the City of St.
4 Louis Annual Operating Plan for Fiscal Year 2006-2007; appropriating and setting apart the sum
5 of One Million, Seven Hundred Eighty Thousand Five Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$1,780,513)
6 in proceeds from the Convention and Sports Facility Project and Refunding Bonds, Series C
7 2007 to Fund 1211 Center 1320001 for costs and expenses of the City for repair, improvement
8 and renovation of Cervantes Convention Center, One Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Eight
9 Hundred Seventy Six Dollars (\$128,876) from interest and sinking fund revenue to Fund 1311
10 Center 1602006 for the payment of interest expenses on the City's 2006 general obligation bond
11 issue and Two Hundred Eighty Six Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety One Dollars (\$286,991)
12 from receipts accruing to the Problem Properties and Nuisance Crime Prosecution Account
13 Center 1390003 and the Enhanced Criminal Prosecution Account Center 3120008 of the Public
14 Safety Trust Fund 1120 for the purpose of funding enhanced problem properties and nuisance
15 crime prosecution efforts of the City Counselor's Office and criminal prosecution efforts of the
16 Circuit Attorney's Office respectively as specified in Ordinance 67193 and detailed in Exhibit A;
17 and containing an emergency clause.

19 WITNESSETH THAT,

20 WHEREAS, the Convention and Sports Facility Project Refunding Bonds, Series C
21 2007 have been issued and proceeds to pay certain capital expenses of the Cervantes
22 Convention Center are available for appropriation, and;

1 WHEREAS, the general obligation bond series authorized by Ordinance 67176 has
2 been issued and interest and sinking fund revenues are available to provide for the first
3 interest payment coming due during the current fiscal year, and;

4
5 WHEREAS, funds have now accrued to the Problem Properties and Nuisance Crime
6 Prosecution Account and the Enhanced Criminal Prosecution account of the Public Safety
7 Trust Fund pursuant to Ordinance 67193 in excess of Two Hundred Eighty Six Thousand
8 Nine Hundred Ninety One Dollars (\$286,991) and are available for appropriation, and;

10 WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of St. Louis, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes
11 supplemental appropriations when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available and
12 the when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same;

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

16 **SECTION ONE.** Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and
17 Apportionment, Ordinance 67090, commonly referred to as the City of St. Louis Annual
18 Operating Plan for Fiscal Year 2006-2007, is hereby amended and there is hereby appropriated
19 and set apart the sum of One Million, Seven Hundred Eighty Thousand Five Hundred Thirteen
20 Dollars (\$1,780,513) in proceeds from the Convention and Sports Facility Project and Refunding
21 Bonds, Series C 2007 to Fund 1211 Center 1320001 for costs and expenses of the City for repair,
22 improvement and renovation of Cervantes Convention Center, One Hundred Twenty Eight
23 Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Six Dollars (\$128,876) from interest and sinking fund revenue

1 to Fund 1311 Center 1602006 for the payment of interest expenses on the City's 2006 general
2 obligation bond issue, Two Hundred Eighty Six Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety One Dollars
3 (\$286,991) from receipts accruing to the Problem Properties and Nuisance Crime Prosecution
4 Account Center 1390003 and the Enhanced Criminal Prosecution Account Center 3120008 of
5 the Public Safety Trust Fund 1120 for the purpose of funding enhanced problem properties and
6 nuisance crime prosecution efforts of the City Counselor's Office and criminal prosecution
7 efforts of the Circuit Attorney's Office respectively as specified in Ordinance 67193 and detailed
8 in Exhibit A.

10 **SECTION TWO.** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance providing for the preservation of
11 public health and safety and providing for current expenses of the City government, it is hereby
12 declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of
13 the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective
14 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
