

BOARD BILL NO. 135 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY

1 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
2 Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the
3 Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis
4 International Airport® (the “Airport”), in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a certain
5 grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting
6 through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation,
7 the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-127-2010, dated July 22, 2010, for a
8 maximum federal obligation of Six Hundred Thirty Two Thousand Eighty Six Dollars
9 (\$632,086), which is filed in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document No. 61429],
10 for the reimbursement of direct costs associated with the design for reconstructing Taxiway Echo
11 (from Taxiway Lima to Taxiway Juliet) (Phase 1 – Design Only); and containing an emergency
12 clause.

13 **BE IT SO ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

14 **SECTION ONE.** The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis
15 (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the
16 “Airport”), in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a grant agreement offered by the
17 United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the Federal Aviation
18 Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being
19 for Project Number 3-29-0085-127-2010, dated July 22, 2010, for a maximum federal obligation
20 of Six Hundred Thirty Two Thousand Eighty Six Dollars (\$632,086), which is filed in the Office

1 of the City Register [Comptroller Document No. 61429], for the reimbursement of direct costs
2 associated with the design for reconstructing Taxiway Echo (from Taxiway Lima to Taxiway
3 Juliet) (Phase 1 – Design Only), is hereby ratified and approved.

4 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,
5 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated
6 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part
7 hereof.

8 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and
9 Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article
10 IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the
11 Mayor of the City.
