

BOARD BILL NO. 149 INTRODUCED BY: ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

1 An ordinance recommended by the Board of Public Service to amend Section One of Ordinance
2 66461 dated November 5, 2004 by revising legal description of Martin Luther King Drive between
3 2nd and 3rd Streets in the City of St. Louis, Missouri, as hereinafter described, in accordance with
4 Charter authority, and in conformity with Section 14 of Article XXI of the Charter and imposing
5 certain conditions on such vacation.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

7 **SECTION ONE:** The public surface rights of vehicle, equestrian and pedestrian travel,
8 between the rights-of-way of:

10 A tract of land being part of Dr. Martin Luther King Drive, \cong 32.08 feet wide,
11 situated between City Blocks 68 and 70 of the City of St. Louis, Missouri, being
12 more particularly described as follows:

14 Beginning at a point by the southeastern corner of City Block 70
15 which is north 80 degrees 08 minutes 27 seconds west 4.37 feet from
16 the original southeast corner of City Block 70; thence south 0 degrees
17 47 minutes 60 seconds west, 32.49 feet to a point; thence north 80
18 degrees 08 minutes 27 seconds west, 167.37 feet to a point; thence
19 north 7 degrees 34 minutes 30 seconds east, 1.02 feet to a point;
20 thence north 74 degrees 8 minutes 54 seconds west, 71.62 feet to a
21 point; thence north 72 degrees 31 minutes 27 seconds west, 19.67
22 feet to a point; thence north 66 degrees 45 minutes 28 seconds west,
23 24.34 feet to a point; thence north 61 degrees 29 minutes 09 seconds
24 west, 19.11 feet to a point; thence north 54 degrees 28 minutes 26
25 seconds west, 8.93 feet to a point; thence north 63 degrees 34
26 minutes 04 seconds west, 1.21 feet to a point; thence north 29
27 degrees 45 minutes 12 seconds west, 6.51 feet to a point; thence
28 south 80 degrees 08 minutes 27 seconds east, 47.73 feet to a point;
29 thence south 80 degrees 08 minutes 27 seconds east, 260.43 feet to a
30 point; to the point of beginning and containing 0.193 acres (8395.862
31 sq. ft) more or less.
