

**BOARD BILL # 156**

**INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

1 An ordinance pertaining to 1520 Market Street recommended by the Board of Public  
2 Service and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, appropriating from fund 1116-  
3 center 1600013 the amount of One Million, Fifty Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty  
4 Seven and Eighteen One-Hundredth dollars (\$1,058,357.18) to be used for the  
5 construction and alterations of said facility; said funds are in addition to the funds  
6 available pursuant to amounts made available in the 2008 Bond Issue, authorized by  
7 Ordinance 67974, Center 6797420; said funds may only be expended upon these  
8 additional funds being placed in said account and no warrant may be drawn upon said  
9 funds by the Comptroller until it has been determined said funds are available and the  
10 President of the Board of Public Service has provided an appropriate voucher for said  
11 funds; and containing an emergency clause.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby appropriated from fund 1116-Center 1600013 an  
14 amount of One Million, Fifty Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty Seven and Eighteen  
15 One Hundredth dollars (\$1,058,357.18) to be used for the construction and alterations of  
16 1520 Market Street; said funds are in addition to the funds available pursuant to the  
17 amounts appropriated in the 2008 Bond Issue, authorized by Ordinance 67974, Center  
18 6797420; said funds may be expended upon these additional funds being placed in said  
19 account and no warrant may be drawn upon said funds by the Comptroller until it has  
20 been determined that the funds are available and the President of the Board of Public  
21 Service has provided an appropriate voucher for said funds.

1           **SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause.** This being an Ordinance for a public  
2 work, it is hereby declared to be an immediate measure within the meaning of Sections  
3 19 and 20 or Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this  
4 Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval of the Mayor.
