

1 **BOARD BILL # 159 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

2 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
3 Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the
4 Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis
5 International Airport® (the “Airport”), in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a certain
6 grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting
7 through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation,
8 the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-109-2007, dated May 8, 2007, for a
9 maximum federal obligation of One Million Eight Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Seven
10 Hundred One Dollars (\$1,849,701), which is filed in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller
11 Document No. 55575], for the reimbursement of direct costs associated with improving runway
12 safety area 12L-30R (Phase 2); and containing an emergency clause.

13 **BE IT SO ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

14 **SECTION ONE.** The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis
15 (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the “Airport”),
16 in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a grant agreement offered by the United States
17 of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the
18 United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-
19 29-0085-109-2007, dated May 8, 2007, for a maximum federal obligation of One Million Eight
20 Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred One Dollars (\$1,849,701), which is filed in the
21 Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document No. 55575], for the reimbursement of direct
22 costs associated with improving runway safety area 12L-30R (Phase 2) is hereby ratified and
23 approved.

1 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,
2 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated
3 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part
4 hereof.

5 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and
6 Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article
7 IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the
8 Mayor of the City.
