

BOARD BILL NO. 16 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

1 An Ordinance, recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
2 Estimate and Apportionment authorizing a supplemental appropriation and set apart in the total
3 amount of Four Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,200,000) from the Airport
4 Development Fund established under Ordinance 59286 approved October 26, 1984, to the "Annual
5 Budget" established under authority of Ordinance No. 67483 approved June 27, 2007 for the fiscal
6 year beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008, for current expenses of the government as
7 detailed in **EXHIBIT "1"** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and containing an
8 emergency clause.

9 **WHEREAS**, the "Annual Budget" was established under authority of Ordinance No. 67483
10 approved on June 27, 2007;

11 **WHEREAS**, the Charter of The City of St. Louis (the "City"), Article XVI, Section 6,
12 authorizes supplemental appropriations when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available
13 and when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same;

14 **WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to authorize a supplemental appropriation to the Annual
15 Budget established under authority of Ordinance No. 67483 in the total amount of Four Million Two
16 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,200,000) for current expenses of the government as detailed in
17 **EXHIBIT "1"** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein;

18 **WHEREAS**, there is a balance in excess of Four Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
19 (\$4,200,000) available for appropriation from the Airport Development Fund established under
20 Ordinance No. 59286 approved October 26, 1984, Exhibit A, Article V, Sections 502 and 510; and

1 **WHEREAS**, this Ordinance is recommended by the Airport Commission and the Board of
2 Estimate and Apportionment.

3 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

4 **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby authorized a supplemental appropriation and set apart in
5 the total amount of Four Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,200,000) from the Airport
6 Development Fund established under Ordinance 59286 approved October 26, 1984, Exhibit A,
7 Article V, Sections 501 and 510, to the "Annual Budget" established under authority of Ordinance
8 No. 67483 approved June 27, 2007 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30,
9 2008, for current expenses of the government as detailed in **EXHIBIT "1"** which is attached hereto
10 and incorporated herein.

11 **SECTION TWO.** In addition to the charter powers granted to the Comptroller to preserve
12 the credit of the City of St. Louis (the "City"), and for that purpose, or in case of any extraordinary
13 emergency of any kind, with the approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and with or
14 without any ordinance or other authority or appropriations therefore, to draw warrants on the
15 treasurer or effect temporary loans to pay debts and judgments and other liabilities of the City, or to
16 meet any such emergency, charging such warrants to any excess balances in appropriations made by
17 this budget ordinance and then specifically reporting such action to the Board of Aldermen at its first
18 meeting thereafter, the Comptroller is hereby directed to cause to be made transfers:

19 a. within departments, divisions of funds, if such transfers are under \$250,000 per
20 occurrence and if they are approved by a majority vote of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment,
21 or

22 b. between or among departments, divisions or funds (except Fund 1217-Capital

1 Improvement Projects), if such funds are under \$250,000 per occurrence and if they are approved by
2 a vote of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

3 **SECTION THREE.** This Ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate
4 preservation of the public peace, health or safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
5 pursuant to Article IV, Section 20, of the City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon
6 passage and approval by the City's Mayor.
