

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 179 INTRODUCED BY ALD. CHARLES QUINCY TROUPE**

2 An ordinance pertaining to public works contracts in the City of St. Louis;
3 amending Section 6 of Ordinance 68412, pertaining to the Community Job Boards.

4 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

5 **SECTION ONE.** Section 6 of Ordinance 68412, is hereby amended to read as
6 follows:

7 **SECTION SIX. Community Jobs Board.** The Mayor of the City of St. Louis
8 with the President of the Board of Aldermen shall appoint a Community Jobs Board with
9 approval from the Board of Aldermen, which shall have ten (10) members. Two (2)
10 members shall be a woman in construction, representative of women in construction; two
11 (2) members shall be minorities in construction, representative of minorities in
12 construction; one (1) member shall be representatives of community organizations; two
13 (2) members shall be representatives of construction labor unions; two (2) members shall
14 be representatives of construction contractors ; and one (1) permanent member shall be
15 the Executive Director of the St. Louis Civil Rights Enforcement Agency. The
16 Executive Director of the St. Louis Civil Rights Enforcement Agency shall serve as the
17 permanent chairperson of the Community Jobs Board. The Community Jobs Board shall
18 review and provide feedback to the Agency on the manner in which this Ordinance is
19 implemented and to review the results of the implementation of this Ordinance and
20 provide feedback to the Agency on whether or not this Ordinance is achieving the
21 intended results. The Agency shall provide quarterly reports, including a report of any
22 waivers granted by the Agency during the preceding quarter, to the Community Jobs
23 Board and shall schedule quarterly meetings of the Community Jobs Board. Members of
24 the Community Jobs Board shall serve in staggered two year terms, except for the
