

1 **BOARD BILL NO.179 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS**
2 **YOUNG, ALDERWOMAN APRIL FORD GRIFFIN**

5 An ordinance pertaining to street vending; amending Section Three of Ordinance
6 68603 to adjust the boundaries of the Downtown Vending District and vending
7 agreements with the Convention and Visitors Commission; and containing an emergency
8 clause.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

10 **SECTION ONE.** Paragraph J of Section Three of Ordinance 68603 is hereby
11 deleted and the following language inserted in its place:

12 J. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, no person shall be permitted to vend on
13 any public sidewalk or within any public right of way within the following described area
14 (also depicted in the diagram attached hereto as Exhibit A) in the Downtown Vending
15 District, unless such person has entered into valid vending agreements with the
16 Convention and Visitors Commission:

17 The area bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the line created 100 feet
18 West of Ninth Street and 100 feet North of Cole Street, thence East along such 100 foot
19 North line of Cole Street to its intersection with the West right-of-way line of I-70, thence
20 South along such West right-of-way line of I-70 to its intersection with the line created
21 100 feet South of Washington Avenue, thence West along such 100 foot South line of
22 Washington Avenue, to its intersection with the 100 foot West line of 9th Street, thence
23 North along such 100 foot West line of 9th Street to its point of beginning.

24 **SECTION TWO: EMERGENCY CLAUSE:** This being an Ordinance for the
25 preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency
