

**BOARD BILL # 183 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN CONWAY**

1 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety, on behalf of the  
2 Mayor and the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the  
3 U. S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, to fund the Justice Assistance  
4 Grant Program, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and to  
5 expend funds by entering into contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and containing an  
6 emergency clause.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **SECTION ONE.** The Mayor and the Director of Public Safety, are hereby  
9 authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a  
10 Grant Agreement with U. S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, to fund  
11 the Justice Assistance Program.

12 **SECTION TWO.** The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and  
13 directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the  
14 funds, which are hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or  
15 otherwise received pursuant to the Grant Agreement, totaling \$1,019,428.00, in a manner  
16 that is consistent with the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached  
17 hereto and shall become part of the ordinance.

18 **SECTION 3.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate  
19 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate  
20 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the  
21 City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon  
22 its passage and approval by the Mayor.
