

1           An ordinance repealing Section Three of Ordinance 63784, approved on June 11,  
2 1996, pertaining to juvenile curfew and regulating their presence in public streets, alleys, right-of-  
3 ways and other similar places enacting in lieu thereof a new ordinance pertaining to the same subject  
4 matter containing an emergency clause.

5                           **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

6                           **SECTION ONE.** Section Three of Ordinance 63784, approved on June 11, 1996,  
7 is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof the following new section is enacted.

8                           **SECTION TWO.** A. It shall be unlawful for any juvenile who is twelve (12) years  
9 of age or younger to be or remain in or upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks or other similar places  
10 within the City of St. Louis during the period ending at 5:00 a.m. and beginning at 10:00 p.m. on  
11 Friday and Saturday nights and at 9:00 p.m. on all other nights, except as provided in Section Four  
12 of Ordinance 67834.

13                           B. It shall be unlawful for any juvenile who is Thirteen (13) or Fourteen (14) years of age to  
14 be or remain in or upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks or other similar places within the City of St.  
15 Louis during the period ending at 5:00 a.m. and beginning at 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday  
16 nights and at 10:00 p.m. on all other nights, except as provided in Section Four of Ordinance 67834.

17                           C. It shall be unlawful for any juvenile fifteen (15) years of age or older to be or remain in  
18 or upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks or similar places within the City of St. Louis at night during the  
19 period ending at 5:00 A.M. and beginning at 11:59 P.M. on Friday and Saturday Night and at 11:00  
20 P.M. on all other nights, except as provided in Section Four of Ordinance 67834.

1                   **SECTION THREE. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.**

2                   This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
3 health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect upon  
4 approval or adoption.
