

1 **BOARD BILL #207 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

2 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and the Director of Public
3 Safety, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement
4 with the Missouri Department of Public Safety to fund the Juvenile Accountability Block
5 Grant for the Nightwatch Program, appropriating said funds and authorizing the Director
6 of Public Safety, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend
7 funds by entering into contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and containing an
8 emergency clause.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

10 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and
11 directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement
12 with the Missouri Department of Public Safety to fund the Juvenile Accountability Block
13 Grant for the Nightwatch Program. Said Grant Agreement shall be substantially in words
14 and figures the same as the attached Agreement, which is made part of this Ordinance
15 and is on file in the Register's Office.

16 **SECTION TWO.** The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and
17 directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the
18 funds, which are hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or
19 otherwise received pursuant to the Grant Agreement, totaling \$243,764.00, in a manner
20 that is consistent with the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached
21 hereto and shall become part of the ordinance.

1 **SECTION THREE** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate
2 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate
3 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the
4 City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
5 its passage and approval by the Mayor.
