

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 218** **INTRODUCED BY: ALDERWOMAN LYDA KREWSON**

3 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, making a
4 supplemental appropriation to the Annual Budget Ordinance No.67972, approved by the Mayor
5 on June 30, 2008, for the Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry for the fiscal year which
6 began July 1, 2008 and ends June 30, 2009, amounting to the sum of One Million Two Hundred
7 Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00); and containing an emergency clause.

8 WHEREAS, the Annual Budget Ordinance No.67972 was approved by the Mayor on
9 June 30, 2008; and

10 WHEREAS, the Charter, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes supplemental appropriations
11 when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available and when the Board of Estimate
12 and Apportionment recommends same; and

13 WHEREAS, there is accrued, unappropriated revenue in the approximate amount of One
14 Million Six Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars in the Forest Park Fund, Cost Center
15 2100002 in Fund 1116; and

16 WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry is in need of One Million,
17 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00) in additional funds for reconstruction of the
18 clubhouse at the Triple A club grounds in Forest Park; and

19 WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment has made a recommendation for
20 the expenditure of the above sum.

21 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

22 **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby appropriated and set apart the sum of One Million Two
23 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00) from the Forest Park Fund Cost Center 2100002 in

1 Fund 1116, to Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry Account 1116-2100002-5652000
2 for reconstruction of the club house at the Triple A club grounds in Forest Park.
3 SECTION TWO. This ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the
4 public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the
5 meaning of Article IV, Sections 19 and 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and shall take
6 effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor or its approval over his veto.
