

1 **BOARD BILL # 220 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

2 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of  
3 Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the  
4 Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis  
5 International Airport® (the “Airport”), in accepting and execution on behalf of the City a certain  
6 grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting  
7 through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation,  
8 the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-95-2005, dated August 18, 2005, for a  
9 maximum federal obligation of Six Million One Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Seven  
10 Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$6,137,729.00), which is filed in the Office of the City Register  
11 Comptroller Document No. 51420, for the reimbursement of direct costs associated with the  
12 rehabilitation of Taxiway N, NW Air Carrier Apron, and Concourse C Apron; and containing an  
13 emergency clause.

14 **BE IT SO ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

15 **SECTION ONE.** The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis  
16 (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the “Airport”),  
17 in accepting and execution on behalf of the City a grant agreement offered by the United States  
18 of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the  
19 United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-  
20 29-0085-95-2005, dated August 18, 2005, for a maximum federal obligation of Six Million One  
21 Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$6,137,729.00), which is  
22 filed in the Office of the City Register Comptroller Document No. 51420, for the reimbursement

1 of direct costs associated with the rehabilitation of Taxiway N, NW Air Carrier Apron, and  
2 Concourse C Apron, is hereby ratified and approved.

3 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,  
4 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated  
5 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part  
6 hereof.

7 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and  
8 Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article  
9 IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the  
10 Mayor of the City.
