

1    **BOARD BILL # 221**                    **INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

2            An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of  
3 Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the  
4 Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis  
5 International Airport® (the “Airport”), in accepting and execution on behalf of the City a certain  
6 grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting  
7 through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation,  
8 the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-97-2005, dated June 10, 2005, for a  
9 maximum federal obligation of One Hundred Seventy Six Thousand One Hundred Seventy Two  
10 Dollars (\$176,172), which is filed in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document No.  
11 50993], for the reimbursement of direct costs associated with an aircraft rescue and fire fighting  
12 vehicle; and containing an emergency clause.

13            **BE IT SO ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

14            **SECTION ONE.** The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis  
15 (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the “Airport”),  
16 in accepting and execution on behalf of the City a grant agreement offered by the United States  
17 of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the  
18 United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-  
19 29-0085-97-2005, dated June 10, 2005, for a maximum federal obligation of One Hundred  
20 Seventy Six Thousand One Hundred Seventy Two Dollars (\$176,172), which is filed in the  
21 Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document No. 50993], and made part hereof, for the  
22 reimbursement of direct costs associated with an aircraft rescue and fire fighting vehicle, is  
23 hereby ratified and approved.

1           **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,  
2 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated  
3 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part  
4 hereof.

5           **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for a Pubic Work and  
6 Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article  
7 IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the  
8 Mayor of the City.
