

1 BOARD BILL NO.221 INTRODUCED BY ALDERPERSONS PHYLLIS YOUNG  
2 & KACIE STARR TRIPLETT

3 An ordinance adopted pursuant to Chapter 24 of the revised Code of the City of St. Louis  
4 extending the boundaries of the Fox Park Historic District as set forth in Ordinance  
5 66098, with an emergency clause.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

7 SECTION ONE. The following described areas (“the Area”) are hereby designated as  
8 part of the Fox Park Historic District as heretofore established by Ordinance 66098:

9 Commencing at the point of intersection of the north line of the public alley north  
10 of Victor Street with the center line of Nebraska Avenue; thence proceeding south along  
11 said center line of Nebraska Avenue to its point of intersection with the center line of  
12 Gravois Avenue; thence proceeding northeast along said center line of Gravois Avenue to  
13 its intersection with the center line of Jefferson Avenue; thence proceeding north along  
14 said center line of Jefferson Ave to its point of intersection with the north line of the  
15 public alley north of Victor Avenue; thence proceeding west along said north line to its  
16 point of intersection with the center line of California Avenue; thence proceeding north  
17 along said center line to its point of intersection with the north line of the alley north of  
18 Victor Avenue; thence proceeding west along said north line to the point of beginning.

1 SECTION TWO.

2 a.) A general location map of the Area shall be maintained on file in the office of the City  
3 Register.

4 b.) The historic district standards to be applied within the Area are the standards of the  
5 existing Fox Park Historic District.

6 SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance necessary for the  
7 immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an  
8 emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the  
9 Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective  
10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
