

1 **Board Bill No. 224 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN KACIE STARR TRIPLETT**

3 An ordinance pertaining to the refuse collection from non-residential premises; repealing  
4 Ordinance 68530, enacted December 14, 2009, and enacting in lieu thereof a new section  
5 pertaining to the same subject matter relating to the refuse collection from non-residential  
6 premises near residentially zoned premises and premises used as a dwelling; and containing an  
7 emergency clause.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE:** Ordinance 68530, enacted December 14, 2009, is hereby repealed and  
10 enacted in lieu thereof is the following:

11 F. No refuse shall be collected from non-residential premises within two hundred (200) feet of  
12 any resident premises or any premises used as a dwelling including, but not limited to, a single-  
13 family dwelling, a two-family dwelling, a multi-family dwelling, a town home, or a semi-  
14 attached two-family, between the hours of eight p.m. and six a.m.

15 **SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause.**

16 The passage of this ordinance being deemed necessary for the preservation of the public peace,  
17 health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective  
18 immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
