3 An ordinance relating to job training; recommended by the Board of Estimate and

4 Apportionment; appropriating the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00)

5 accrued and unappropriated City revenue for payment to Better Family Life, Inc.

6 Whereas, Pursuant to a Settlement Agreement authorized by Ordinance 65432, approved March

7 4, 2002, Charter Communications paid to the City the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars

8 (\$300,000.00) to fund a job skills/internship training program for telecommunications; and

9 Whereas, such money has not been appropriated and is held in Fund 5117 (Communications

10 Division), Fund Center 4010018; and

11 Whereas, the Charter, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes supplemental appropriations when any

12 accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available and when the Board of Estimate and

13 Apportionment recommends same; and

14 Whereas, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment has made a recommendation for the

15 expenditure of the above sum.

16 Whereas, Better Family Life, Inc. is a community development 501 (c)(3) corporation

17 dedicated to the prosperity and growth of the American family, with centers in several locations

18 in the St. Louis Metropolitan area; and

19 Whereas, Better Family Life, Inc. conducts numerous programs of benefit to the residents of the

20 City, including job training and placement programs, and has proposed to the City

21 that the City and Better Family Life enter into a cooperation agreement for job training for City

22 residents; and

23 Whereas, the Board of Aldermen believes that such job training would be in the best interests of

24 residents of the City;
