

1 **BOARD BILL # 245** **INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

2 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
3 Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the
4 Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis
5 International Airport® (the “Airport”), in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a certain
6 grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting
7 through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation,
8 the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-100-2006, dated September 5, 2006,
9 for a maximum federal obligation of Nine Million Eight Hundred Nine Thousand One Hundred
10 Twenty Eight Dollars (\$9,809,128), which is filed in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller
11 Document No. 53820], for the reimbursement of direct costs associated with rehabilitating
12 Taxiway F, Phase 1; and containing an emergency clause.

13 **BE IT SO ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

14 **SECTION ONE.** The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis
15 (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the “Airport”),
16 in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a grant agreement offered by the United States
17 of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the
18 United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-
19 29-0085-100-2006, dated September 5, 2006, for a maximum federal obligation of Nine Million
20 Eight Hundred Nine Thousand One Hundred Twenty Eight Dollars (\$9,809,128), which is filed
21 in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document No. 53820], for the reimbursement of
22 direct costs associated with rehabilitating Taxiway F, Phase 1 is hereby ratified and approved.

1 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,
2 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated
3 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part
4 hereof.

5 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for a Pubic Work and
6 Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article
7 IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the
8 Mayor of the City.
