

1 **BOARD BILL # 260** **INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

2 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
3 Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the
4 Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis
5 International Airport®, in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a certain grant
6 agreement offered by the United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the
7 Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant
8 Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-105-2007, dated June 21, 2007, for a maximum
9 federal obligation of Three Million Eight Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$3,840,000), which
10 is filed in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document No. 55837], for the
11 reimbursement of direct costs associated with Noise Mitigation Acoustical Program for
12 residencies within 65-69 DNL (Phase 6); and containing an emergency clause.

13 **BE IT SO ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

14 **SECTION ONE.** The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis
15 (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport®, in accepting
16 and executing on behalf of the City a grant agreement offered by the United States of America
17 (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United
18 States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-
19 105-2007, dated June 21, 2007, for a maximum federal obligation of Three Million Eight
20 Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$3,840,000), which is filed in the Office of the City Register
21 [Comptroller Document No. 55837], for the reimbursement of direct costs associated with Noise
22 Mitigation Acoustical Program for residencies within 65-69 DNL (Phase 6), is hereby ratified
23 and approved.

1 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,
2 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated
3 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part
4 hereof.

5 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and
6 Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article
7 IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the
8 Mayor of the City.
