

**BOARD BILL NO. 290      INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN DONNA BARINGER**

1            An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close,  
2            barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on McCausland Avenue by blocking said  
3            traffic flow at a point 156 feet west of the west curb line of Chippewa Street and further  
4            authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise  
5            impede the flow of traffic on Plainview Avenue by blocking said traffic flow at a point 155 feet  
6            west of the west curb line of Jamieson Avenue and further authorizing and directing the Director  
7            of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Hiview  
8            Avenue by blocking said traffic flow at a point 155 feet west of the west curb line of Jamieson  
9            Avenue, and containing an emergency clause.

10            **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

11            SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and  
12            barricade, for a period of three months, McCausland Avenue at a point 156 feet west of the west  
13            curb line of Chippewa Street.

14            SECTION TWO: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and  
15            barricade, for a period of three months, Plainview Avenue at a point 155 feet west of the west  
16            curb line of Jamieson Avenue.

17            SECTION THREE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close  
18            and barricade, for a period of three months, Hiview Avenue at a point 155 feet west of the west  
19            curb line of Jamieson Avenue.

1           SECTION FOUR. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of  
2 public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the  
3 meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore  
4 this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
