

BOARD BILL NO. 315 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

1 An Ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission, Board of Public
2 Service, and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment authorizing a First Amendment to Section
3 One of the Airport Planning Project Ordinance 66870 approved November 15, 2005, which
4 authorized a multi-year public work and improvement program (the “Project”) at Lambert-St. Louis
5 International Airport® (the “Airport”), increasing the total estimated costs of the Project by One
6 Million Six Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,625,000) to Three Million Dollars
7 (\$3,000,000); authorizing a First Supplemental Appropriation in the total amount of One Million Six
8 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,650,000) from the Airport Development Fund established
9 under Ordinance 59286, Section 13, approved October 26, 1984, into the Airport Planning Project
10 Ordinance 66870 as amended for the payment of costs authorized therein; containing a severability
11 clause; and containing an emergency clause.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **SECTION ONE.** Section One of the Airport Planning Project Ordinance 66870
14 approved November 15, 2005, is hereby amended by deleting the following words and figures from
15 the last clause of said section:

16 “and other related work or cost for a total estimated cost of One Million Three
17 Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,375,000).”

18 and replacing with the following words and figures:

19 “and other related work or cost for a total estimated cost of Three Million
20 Dollars (\$3,000,000).”

21 **SECTION TWO.** There is hereby authorized a First Supplement Appropriation in

1 the total amount of One Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,650,000) from the
2 Airport Development Fund established under Ordinance 59286, Section 13, approved October
3 26, 1984, into the Airport Planning Project Ordinance 66870 as amended for the payment of
4 costs authorized therein.

5 **SECTION THREE.** The sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance or portions
6 thereof shall be severable. If any section, condition, or provision of this Ordinance or portion thereof
7 is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining
8 sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance.

9 **SECTION FOUR.** This being an Ordinance providing for a public work and
10 improvement program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV,
11 Section 20, of the City of St. Louis' Charter and shall become effective immediately upon approval
12 by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
