

1 BOARD BILL NO. 326 INTRODUCED BY: Alderman Phyllis Young

2 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the City Counselor on behalf of the City
3 of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the Office of the Secretary
4 of State for a grant to fund a Local Records Preservation Project for the City Counselor's
5 Office, appropriating said funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 and authorizing the City
6 Counselor on behalf of the City, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and
7 Apportionment, to expend the funds by entering into contracts or otherwise for grant
8 purposes and containing an emergency clause.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

10 **SECTION ONE.** The City Counselor is hereby authorized and directed, on
11 behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the
12 Office of the Secretary of State for a grant to fund a Records Preservation Project. Said
13 Grant Agreement shall be substantially in words and figures as the attached Agreement,
14 which is made part of this Ordinance and is on file in the Register's Office.

15 **SECTION TWO.** The City Counselor is hereby authorized and directed, upon
16 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds in the amount
17 of \$5,000.00, which are hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts
18 or otherwise for grant purposes pursuant to the Grant Agreement in a manner that is
19 consistent with the provisions of said Agreement.

20 **SECTION THREE.** This being an Ordinance providing for the preservation of
21 public health and safety, it is hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Sections 19
22 and 20 of Article VI of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and this Ordinance shall
23 become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
