

**BOARD BILL NO. 376 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

1 An Ordinance recommended and approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment  
2 authorizing and directing the Director of Airports and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the  
3 "City") to enter into and execute on behalf of the City the East Terminal Agency Agreement AL-446  
4 with a term ending December 31, 2010 (the "Agreement") at Lambert-St. Louis International  
5 Airport® (the "Airport") between the City and Airport Terminal Services Inc, a Missouri  
6 corporation (the "Agent"), granting to the Agent the right, license, and privilege to act as the City's  
7 agent in the management of gate assignments and scheduling within the Premises (as defined in  
8 Section 201 of the Agreement), and the right to provide certain other services to users of the Airport  
9 subject to the terms, covenants, and conditions of the Agreement; the Agreement, which was  
10 approved by the City's Airport Commission and the City's Board of Estimate and Apportionment  
11 and is attached hereto as **ATTACHMENT "1"** and is incorporated herein, requires the Agent to  
12 provide certain services and to make certain payments to the City for the rights and privileges  
13 therein granted by the City; directing that the Agreement be in compliance with all applicable  
14 minority and women business enterprise requirements and in compliance with all applicable federal,  
15 state, and local laws, ordinances, regulations, court decisions, and executive orders relating to equal  
16 employment opportunity; and containing a severability clause; and an emergency clause.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

18 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Airports and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the  
19 "City") are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City the East  
20 Terminal Agency Agreement AL-446 with a term ending December 31, 2010 (the "Agreement") at

1 Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the “Airport”) between the City and Airport Terminal  
2 Services Inc, a Missouri corporation (the “Agent”), granting to the Agent the right, license, and  
3 privilege to act as the City’s agent in the management of gate assignments and scheduling within the  
4 Premises (as defined in Section 201 of the Agreement), and the right to provide certain other  
5 services to users of the Airport subject to the terms, covenants, and conditions of the Agreement; the  
6 Agreement, which was approved by the City’s Airport Commission and the City’s Board of  
7 Estimate and Apportionment is to read in words and figures as substantially set out in  
8 **ATTACHMENT "1"** which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

9 **SECTION TWO.** This Agreement shall be in compliance with all applicable minority and  
10 women business enterprise requirements and in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and  
11 local laws, ordinances, regulations, court decisions, and executive orders relating to equal  
12 employment opportunity.

13 **SECTION THREE.** The sections, conditions, and provisions of this Ordinance or portions  
14 thereof shall be severable. If any section, condition, or provision of this Ordinance or portion thereof  
15 contained herein is held invalid by the court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not  
16 invalidate the remaining sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance.

17 **SECTION FOUR.** This being an Ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, or  
18 safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20 of the  
19 City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City.
