

1 **BOARD BILL #392 INTRODUCED BY: ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY AND**
2 **ALDERMAN STEPHEN GREGALI**

3 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety, on behalf
4 of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the Office of
5 Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance to fund a Bulletproof Vest Partnership
6 Agreement, appropriating said funds and authorizing the Director of Public Safety, upon
7 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend funds by entering into
8 contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and containing an emergency clause.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

10 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and
11 directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement
12 with the Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance to fund a Bulletproof
13 Vest Partnership Agreement. Said Grant Agreement shall be substantially in words and
14 figures the same as the attached Agreement, which is made part of this Ordinance and is
15 on file in the Register's Office.

16 **SECTION TWO.** The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and
17 directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the
18 funds, which are hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or
19 otherwise received pursuant to the Grant Agreement, totaling \$8,804.47, in a manner that
20 is consistent with the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto
21 and shall become part of the ordinance.

22 **SECTION 3.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate
23 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate

1 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the
2 City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
3 its passage and approval by the Mayor.
