

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 426** **INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN SAMUEL L. MOORE**

2 An Ordinance directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade, or
3 otherwise impede the flow of traffic on north Market Street at the east curb line of Marcus
4 Avenue; on Dick Gregory Place at the north curb line of Dr. Martin Luther King Drive; remove,
5 redirect and establish the direction of Aldine Avenue as a one way street from eastbound to
6 westbound; remove, redirect and establish the direction of Leduc as a one way street from
7 eastbound to westbound; remove, redirect and establish the direction of Cote Brilliante Avenue
8 as a one way street from eastbound to westbound, and containing an emergency clause.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

10 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and
11 barricade the flow of traffic on north Market Street at the east curb line of Marcus Avenue and
12 on Dick Gregory Place at the north curb line of Dr. Martin Luther King Drive.

13 **SECTION TWO:** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to remove Aldine Avenue
14 as a one way street eastbound from Dick Gregory Place to Marcus Avenue and is authorized to
15 establish Aldine Avenue as a one way street westbound from Dick Gregory Place to Marcus
16 Avenue.

17 **SECTION THREE:** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to remove Leduc
18 Avenue as a one way street eastbound from Dick Gregory Place to Marcus Avenue and is
19 authorized to establish Leduc Avenue as a one way street westbound from Dick Gregory Place to
20 Marcus Avenue.

21 **SECTION FOUR:** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to remove Cote
22 Brilliante Avenue as a one way street eastbound from Dick Gregory Place to Marcus Avenue

1 and is authorized to establish Cote Brilliante as a one way street westbound from Dick Gregory
2 Place to Marcus Avenue.

3 **SECTION FOUR: EMERGENCY CLAUSE:** This being an Ordinance for the
4 preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency
5 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St.
6 Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and
7 approval by the Mayor.
