

1 **BOARD BILL #439 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY**

2 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Fire Chief, on behalf of the City of St.  
3 Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the Federal Emergency  
4 Management Agency to fund a fire prevention and safety program entitled “Meeting  
5 Neighbors and Saving Lives”, appropriating said funds and authorizing the Fire Chief,  
6 upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend funds by entering  
7 into contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and containing an emergency clause.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and  
10 directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement  
11 with the Federal Emergency Management Agency to fund a fire prevention and safety  
12 program entitled “Meeting Neighbors and Saving Lives.” Said Grant Agreement shall be  
13 substantially in words and figures the same as the attached Agreement, which is made  
14 part of this Ordinance and is on file in the Register’s Office.

15 **SECTION TWO.** The Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed, upon  
16 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds, which are  
17 hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or otherwise received  
18 pursuant to the Grant Agreement, totaling \$85,100.00, in a manner that is consistent with  
19 the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and shall become  
20 part of the ordinance.

21 **SECTION 3.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate  
22 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate  
23 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the

- 1 City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
- 2 its passage and approval by the Mayor.
