

BOARD BILL # 51 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY

1 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
2 Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing and directing the Director of Airports and the
3 Comptroller on behalf of the City of St. Louis (the "City") the owner and operator of Lambert-St.
4 Louis International Airport[®] (the "Airport") to accept and execute on behalf of the City a certain
5 Other Transaction Agreement (the "Agreement") offered by the Federal Aviation Administration
6 for the purchase and installation of Airport Surface Detection Equipment ("ASDE"), ASDE-X
7 monitor(s), and ASDE-X system enhancement communication equipment at the Airport for a
8 maximum obligation of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for the purchase and
9 installation associated with the projects funded under the Agreement; and containing an
10 emergency clause.

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

12 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Airports and the Comptroller on behalf of the City of
13 St. Louis (the "City"), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport[®] (the
14 "Airport"), are hereby authorized to accept and execute on behalf of the City an Other
15 Transaction Agreement (the "Agreement") offered by the Federal Aviation Administration
16 substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein, which provides
17 financial assistance to the City for the purchase and installation of Airport Surface Detection
18 Equipment ("ASDE"), ASDE-X monitor(s), and ASDE-X system enhancement communication
19 equipment at the Airport (the "Project") for a maximum obligation of Five Hundred Thousand
20 Dollars (\$500,000) for purchase and installation of direct costs of the City associated with the
21 Project.

1 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,
2 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the Agreement and the incorporated
3 materials referred to in the Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part hereof.

4 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for the preservation of the
5 public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in
6 Article IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon
7 approval of the Mayor of the City.
