

**BOARD BILL NO. 516    INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN CONWAY**

1            An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment,  
2 making a supplemental appropriation to the Annual Budget Ordinance No. 67483,  
3 approved by the Mayor on June 27, 2007, for programs of the Affordable Housing  
4 Commission for the fiscal year which began July 1, 2007 and ends June 30, 2008,  
5 amounting to the sum of Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000); and  
6 containing an emergency clause.

7    **WHEREAS**, the Annual Budget Ordinance No. 67483 was approved by the Mayor on  
8 June 27, 2007; and

9    **WHEREAS**, the Charter, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes supplemental appropriations  
10 when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available and when the Board of  
11 Estimate and Apportionment recommends same; and

12    **WHEREAS**, there is accrued, unappropriated revenue in the approximate amount of  
13 One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars in the Excess Use Tax Trust Fund; and

14    **WHEREAS**, the Affordable Housing Commission is in need of Two Hundred Fifty  
15 Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) in additional funds for home foreclosure crisis relief  
16 and One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) for home heating aid for the  
17 remainder of the fiscal year; and

18    **WHEREAS**, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment made a recommendation for the  
19 expenditure of the above sum.

1 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, AS**  
2 **FOLLOWS:**  
3 **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby appropriated and set apart the sum of Three Hundred  
4 Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000) from the Excess Use Tax Trust Fund to the Use  
5 Tax Fund 1110, Department 143, Subsidy for Housing Assistance, Line Item 5666582.  
6 **SECTION TWO.** This ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate  
7 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an  
8 emergency measure within the meaning of Article IV, Sections 19 and 20, of the Charter  
9 of the City of St. Louis, and shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor  
10 or its approval over his veto.
