

1 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying the
2 actions of the Mayor in submitting, on behalf of organizations preparing applications and the City of
3 St. Louis, in applying for CDBG Disaster Grants to the Missouri Department of Economic
4 Development (“MoDED”); authorizing and directing the Mayor and the Comptroller to enter into
5 and execute agreements with the MoDED for CDBG Disaster Grants as further described in Exhibit
6 A, appropriating the sum of Seven Million Two Hundred Ninety Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-
7 Eight Dollars (\$7,290,338) awarded by MoDED pursuant to the aforementioned applications;
8 authorizing and directing the Director of the Community Development Administration (“CDA”) to
9 contract with municipal agencies, non-profit corporations and other entities as necessary for the
10 expenditure of CDBG Disaster Grants directing the Comptroller to issue warrants thereon upon the
11 City Treasury; and containing an emergency clause.

12 WHEREAS, the President declared a major disaster under Title IV of the Robert T. Stafford
13 Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act in 2008; and,

14 WHEREAS, certain counties and cities not within a county in the State of Missouri
15 experienced severe flooding in 2008; and

16 WHEREAS, those counties and cities not within a county were officially designated by the
17 Governor of Missouri and the President of the United States of America as disaster areas; and,

18 WHEREAS, Congress approved the Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance and
19 Continuing Appropriations Act of 2009 (Public Law 110-329), which appropriated \$6.5 billion in
20 Community Development Block Grant funds for necessary expenses related to disaster relief, long-
21 term recovery and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected
22 by hurricanes, flooding and other natural disasters that occurred during 2008; and

1 WHEREAS, additional 2008 CDBG funds from this Act (“CDBG Disaster Funds”) were
2 made available to the State of Missouri to address needs of those officially designated counties and
3 cities not within a county; and

4 WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Economic Development (“MoDED”) is
5 administering said 2008 CDBG Disaster Funds; and,

6 WHEREAS, MoDED issued a Request for Proposals on August 12, 2009, and September
7 15, 2009, soliciting grant applications for CDBG Disaster Funds (“CDBG Disaster Grants”) and
8 such Requests for Proposals were published on the Missouri Department of Economic Development
9 website; and

10 WHEREAS, a number of organizations prepared applications for such CDBG Disaster
11 Grants; and

12 WHEREAS, the Request for Proposals required that the City of St. Louis submit the
13 applications on behalf of such applicants; and

14 WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of St. Louis signed a number of such applications on
15 behalf of such applicants and such applicants submitted the applications to MoDED; and

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to such applications, MoDED awarded four (4) CDBG Disaster
17 Grants to organizations in the City of St. Louis, as summarized on Exhibit A hereto; and

18 WHEREAS, MoDED requires that the City of St. Louis accept the CDBG Disaster Grants
19 and expend the funding for the purposes specified by MoDED in response to the applications; and

20 WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis wishes to accept these CDBG Disaster Grants and expend
21 the funding for such purposes.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section One. The City’s submissions to the MoDED for CDBG Disaster Grants by the
2 Mayor of the City of St. Louis acting on behalf of various organizations and the City is hereby
3 ratified and approved.

4 Section Two. There is hereby appropriated the total sum of Seven Million Two Hundred
5 Ninety Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$7,290,338), which funding was awarded
6 by MoDED in CDBG Disaster Grants for the purposes described in Exhibit A attached hereto and
7 incorporated herein by reference. The Director of CDA is hereby authorized to make, negotiate and
8 execute any and all contracts or other documents necessary to carry out the activities for which such
9 CDBG Disaster Grants were made available by MoDED and to expend said funds for the purposes
10 and in the amounts specified in Exhibit A attached hereto, and the Comptroller is authorized and
11 directed to issue warrants upon the City Treasury for payment thereon.

12 Section Three. This being an ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the
13 public peace, health and safety and making appropriations for the payment of principal and
14 interest on public debt and for the current expenses of the City government, an emergency is
15 hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Section 20, Article IV, of the Charter and this
16 ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the
17 Mayor.
