

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 76CS INTRODUCED BY ALD. CHARLES QUINCY TROUPE**

2 An ordinance pertaining to business licenses in the City of St. Louis; amending
3 subsection 8.02.110 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, pertaining to the police
4 duties and amending subsection 8.02.120 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis,
5 pertaining to violations; containing an emergency clause.

6 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

7 **SECTION ONE.** Subsection 8.02.110 of the Revised Code of the City of St.
8 Louis, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 8.02.110 Police duties.

10 It shall be the duty of the police to prevent any persons carrying on a business
11 or object for which a license is required without having a license for that purpose. They
12 shall report to the License Collector all violations of the laws and ordinances relating to
13 licenses and license taxes. They shall report to the Collector of Revenue all violations of
14 the laws and ordinances relating to personal property tax or earnings tax.

15 **SECTION TWO.** Subsection 8.02.120 of the Revised Code of the City of St.
16 Louis, is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 8.02.120 Violations.

18 The License Collector shall report to the police all persons who fail to take out
19 the proper license or pay the license tax, and the police shall cause the arrest and
20 conviction of offenders. The Collector of Revenue shall report to the police all firms,
21 businesses or corporations whom fail to properly report or pay personal property tax or
22 earnings tax, and the police shall cause the arrest and conviction of offenders.

23 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency clause.

24 This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it
