

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 67 CS INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN LYDA KREWSON,**  
2 **ALFRED WESSELS, STEPHEN GREGALI, PHYLLIS YOUNG, KEN ORTMANN,**  
3 **KATHLEEN HANRAHAN, WILLIAM WATERHOUSE**

4 An ordinance pertaining to food service establishments; permitting a food service  
5 establishment to allow a customer to be accompanied by a dog in the permitted outdoor dining  
6 area of such food service establishment located within the City of St Louis, except the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>,  
7 3<sup>rd</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 18, and 27<sup>th</sup> wards, under certain conditions.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE:** A food service establishment may permit a customer to be  
10 accompanied by a dog in an outdoor dining area if:

- 11 1. The food service establishment posts a sign in a conspicuous location stating that  
12 dogs are allowed in the outdoor dining area; and
- 13 2. the food service establishment provides waterless hand sanitizer in a convenient  
14 location for customers and employees, or upon request; and
- 15 3. the food service establishment immediately cleans up any unsanitary condition  
16 resulting from a dog; and
- 17 4. the customer and the dog access the outdoor dining area directly from the exterior of  
18 the food service establishment; and
- 19 5. the dog does not enter the interior of the food service establishment; and
- 20 6. the customer keeps the dog on a leash which keep the dog close to the customer; and
- 21 7. the customer controls the dog; and

- 1       8.     the operator of the food service establishment may ask the customer to remove any
- 2             dog whose activities or behavior are deemed undesirable or disruptive at the sole
- 3             discretion of the operator; and
- 4       9.     the customer does not allow the dog on a seat, table, countertop, or similar surface;
- 5             and
- 6       10.    the customer does not allow the dog to come in contact with plates or utensils; and
- 7       11.    in the outdoor dining area, the food service establishment does not:
- 8             a.     prepare food; or
- 9             b.     permit open food, except for food that is being served to a customer.
