

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 162CS INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JEFFREY BOYD**

3 An Ordinance which amends Ordinance 68536, Section Four, paragraph

4 14.03.110 of the Excise Code of the City of St. Louis, pertaining to the minimum

5 quantity in original package- Liquor other than beer; and containing an emergency

6 clause.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **SECTION ONE.** Paragraph 14.03.110 in Section Four of Ordinance

9 68536, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 14.03.110 Minimum quantity in original package-Liquor other than beer.

11 No person licensed under the provisions of this chapter or title, his agent, servant

12 or employee shall sell intoxicating liquor at retail in the original package to be consumed

13 off of the premises where sold, in any container with a liquid content of less than fifty

14 (50) milliliters.

15 **SECTION TWO.** Emergency Clause. The passage of this ordinance

16 being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

17 safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Section 20 of

18 Article IV of the Charter, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately

19 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
