3 ALD. CRAIG N. SCHMID

4 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Civil Service Commission pertaining to
5 employee benefits, amending Section Twenty-two of Ordinance 67333 by authorizing the
6 City Health Insurance Committee to recommend programs for health/medical insurance
7 coverage for employees in the Classified Service and others.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

9 SECTION ONE: Section Twenty-two of Ordinance 67333 is hereby amended to read as
10 follows:

11 Section Twenty-two:

12 Insurance Benefits

13 The City of St. Louis is hereby authorized to devise and establish by contract or
14 otherwise plans for life, health medical, disability, and other insurance coverage deemed
15 necessary for employees in the classified service and other employees of the City and
16 their dependents. As provided in Board Bill 117, the City Health Insurance Committee
17 shall recommend programs to provide for health/medical insurance coverage. The
18 Director of Personnel shall be responsible for the administration of any such
19 health/medical insurance programs as may be authorized by law.

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1 The Committee shall make its recommendations annually in a timely manner to enable
2 the Director to confer with Board of Estimate and Apportionment by February 1st of each
3 year regarding coverage plans and appropriate funding levels. The Director shall then be
4 charged with the responsibility of establishing the applicable funding level and
5 remittance rates for the aforementioned plans and certify same to the Comptroller and
6 Budget Director by March 1st of each year and no officer or employee shall alter or
7 amend such rates.

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
