INTRODUCED BY ALDERMEN TERRY KENNEDY

3
4 An ordinance providing for and directing the submission to the qualified electors of the City
5 of St. Louis at a special bond election to be held in said City on the 8th day of November, 2005 of a
6 proposal for the incurring of indebtedness and the issuance of bonds of said City in evidence thereof
7 in the aggregate amount of not to exceed Thirteen Million Dollars (\$13,000,000) upon the assent to
8 the said proposal of two-thirds of the qualified electors of said City voting thereon, and containing
9 an emergency clause.

10 **WHEREAS**, it has become necessary to provide for the making of certain public
11 improvements in and for the City of St. Louis, as hereinafter more particularly set forth and
12 described; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the aggregate of the estimated costs of said improvements is approximately
14 Thirteen Million Dollars (\$13,000,000); and

15 **WHEREAS**, sufficient funds are not now available in the treasury of said City with which to
16 pay said costs; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the said City is authorized under the Constitution and Statutes of the State of
18 Missouri and under the Charter of said City to incur indebtedness for the purposes hereinafter set
19 forth, provided that the proposals for the incurring of such indebtedness be assented to by two-thirds
20 of the qualified electors of said City voting on said proposition at an election to be held for that
21 purpose, and provided, further that the amount of such indebtedness, when added to the outstanding
22 indebtedness of said City, shall not exceed the limits of indebtedness imposed by the Constitution
23 and Statutes of the State of Missouri and by the Charter of the City of St. Louis; and

3 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special bond election will be held in the City of St. Louis,

13 designated or to be designated by the Board of Election Commissioners of the City of St. Louis,
14 Missouri, separate notice of which will be given by said Board.

16 Subject to such modifications as may be required by the use of an electronic voting system, the
17 ballots to be used at said election shall be in substantially the following form, to-wit:

26 To vote in favor of the proposition submitted upon this ballot, place a cross (X) mark in
27 the square opposite the word "YES"; and, to vote against the said proposition, place a cross (X)
28 mark in the square opposite the word "NO".

32 Shall the following be adopted:

34 Proposition to issue bonds of the City of St. Louis, Missouri in an amount not to exceed Thirteen
35 Million Dollars (\$13,000,000) for the purpose of funding a portion of the cost of replacing,
36 improving, and maintaining the City of St. Louis' radio system used by the St. Louis Police
37 Department, Fire Department, the Emergency Medical Services, and other City departments;
38 and, for the purpose of funding a portion of the costs of reconstructing, repairing and improving
39 major streets, bridges, and the flood wall, where Federal funding is available and local funding is
40 required.

31 Proof of the publication of said notice shall be made by affidavits of the publishers of said
32 newspapers, with a copy of such publication attached thereto, and such affidavits shall be filed with
33 the City Register.

34 **SECTION FOUR.** That the Board of Election Commissioners for the City of St. Louis,
35 Missouri shall provide the ballots, conduct the election, and certify the results of said special bond
36 election to the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis, Missouri, as required by law.

1 **SECTION FIVE.** That if the said proposition be assented to by two-thirds (2/3) or more
2 of the qualified electors voting thereon, bonds in the amount and for the purpose designated in said
3 proposition may be issued.

4 **SECTION SIX.** That the proceeds of the sale or sales of any of the bonds which may
5 be authorized by the requisite affirmative vote shall be used only for the purpose designated in the
6 proposition with which the bonds are identified.

7 **SECTION SEVEN.** That immediately upon the passage and approval of this ordinance, the
8 Clerk of the Board of Aldermen shall certify a copy thereof to the Board of Election Commissioners
9 for the City of St. Louis, Missouri for action and proceedings by said Board in accordance herewith
10 and as required by law.

11 **SECTION EIGHT.** This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health
12 and safety, and providing for submission to the people, it is hereby declared to be an emergency
13 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St.
14 Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval
15 by the Mayor.
