

RESOLUTION NUMBER 8
Officer Corey Zinkl

WHEREAS, St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department Officer Corey Zinkl was selected by his peers as the 2015 Officer of the Year for District 1; and

WHEREAS, Officer Zinkl graduated from the Police Academy on January 9, 2014, and was assigned to the 1st District for his field training, which he completed on January 9, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Officer Zinkl earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Southeast Missouri State University in 2012; and

WHEREAS, Officer Zinkl became partners with Officer Samuel Rachas in December 2014; and

WHEREAS, Officer Zinkl and Officer Rachas were selected twice as Officers of the Month in 2015, once in January and once in July. In January 2015 they conducted numerous car stops and pedestrian checks, resulting in 11 arrests, accounting for 16 felony charges and 47 overall charges. In July 2015 they handled 165 radio assignments and made numerous car and pedestrian stops resulting in 9 arrests, with 14 felony charges and a total of 37 charges overall.

WHEREAS, Officer Zinkl is a professional and dedicated police officer and has earned the title of Officer of the Year 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize Officer Corey Zinkl for being awarded 2015 Officer of the Year honors for District 1. We further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a memorial copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
