WHEREAS, he is 83 years old and an Elder at Total Praise And Worship Center; and

WHEREAS, he was the first African-American professional to work for the St. Louis District Branch of the United States Food and Drug Administration where he served as Chief of the Information Management Branch; and

WHEREAS, Gene retired after 49 years and six months of federal service which included 2 years in the Army during the Korean Conflict period; and

WHEREAS, he was married to the late Florida Bosley and together they had 3 children; and

WHEREAS, in his walk with the Lord, Elder Bosley has ministered salvation, deliverance, and healing to many.
