

RESOLUTION NO. 35
Paris Climate Agreement

WHEREAS, the St. Louis Board of Aldermen recognizes the Paris Climate Agreement and commits to upholding the guidelines of the Paris Climate Agreement throughout the City of St. Louis; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis will work in partnership with other cities to meet current climate goals, push for new action to meet the 1.5 degrees Celsius target, and work together to create a 21st century clean energy economy; and

WHEREAS, the Paris Climate Agreement is an agreement made by representatives of 196 nations on December 12, 2015 to adopt green energy sources, cut down on climate change emissions and limit the rise of global temperatures; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis will join the 187 other cities across the United States who have also committed to undertake ambitious efforts to combat climate change and adapt to its effects.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we recognize the Paris Climate Agreement and commit to upholding the guidelines of the agreement throughout the City of St. Louis.
