

RESOLUTION NUMBER 38

Arthur H. Lieber

WHEREAS, Arthur H. Lieber, Jr. co-founded Crossroads School in 1974, when he was only 27 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the first location of the school was in Laclede Town in Midtown of the City of Saint Louis; and

WHEREAS, the second location was on Lindell Boulevard in the Central West End of the City of Saint Louis, serving 75 students; and

WHEREAS, the school's third location at 500 DeBaliviere Avenue opened in 1980, aided in enhancing and revitalizing a community by renovating an abandoned grocery store and offering an education to 125 students and expanded to the twelfth grade; and

WHEREAS, the first senior class of 12 students graduated in 1982 and more than 845 have graduated since that time; and

WHEREAS, Crossroads has matured into an academic institution that brings students from 60 zip codes around the region to the City of Saint Louis and continues to positively impact the community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Saint Louis that we pause in our deliberations to congratulate and recognize Arthur H. Lieber on the 30th anniversary of the first high school graduating class of Crossroads College Preparatory School and for his many contributions to the City of Saint Louis and we further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
