**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Gore stands as the longest lifetime member of the Auxiliary's Board of Directors, a role she holds with distinction for her ongoing ability to recruit new volunteers and Auxiliary members; and

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Gore, through her generosity and her giving of time, a listening ear, and a hand to hold, has touched thousands of lives, helping the Psychiatric Center rapidly stabilize patients and prevent those suffering from mental disorders from relapsing; and
