He co-wrote the course of study for Ethics in Science and Technology, which was taught exclusively at Gateway Institute of Technology. He received the honor of Secondary School Teacher of the Year in 1999; and

Whereas, Sandra is a former president of Beta Theta Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma. She is an avid reader and volunteers as a reading tutor. Michael is a past president of the Missouri Numismatic Society and the World Coin Club of Missouri. He is a co-founder of the Ancient Coin Study Group. He was the founder and editor of the *Missouri Journal of Numismatics*. He is also a co-author of *Chits, Chiselers, and Funny Money*, which is a history of sales tax tokens in the United States; and

Whereas, Michael and Sandra are proud parents of Michael Jr. and Patricia. They have four grandchildren: Sarah, Colin, Molly and Allison.
