Officer Will Gaddy

WHEREAS, a St. Louis native, Will served with the United States Marine Corps as an infantryman after high school. He was assigned to 1st Battalion, 5th Marine Regiment and later, post 9/11 to the Department of Justice ordered 1st USMC Quick Reaction Force responsible for the Los Angeles and San Francisco areas; and

WHEREAS, after his tour with the Marines ended it began with the Metropolitan Police Department. He joined the department in 2010 and served notably and honorably in the Sixth District for the past four years. Will has been a dedicated and professional officer playing a key part in the success of the Sixth District's "A" Platoon as well as the District and Department in their entirety; and

WHEREAS, earlier this year Will was diagnosed with an aggressive disease of the central nervous system that has kept him from his police work. Will has recently reached the point where he will be unable to return to work. He has exhausted his available sick time and is quickly approaching the end of tenure that provides his insurance and medical coverage. Will's condition currently leaves him unable to work and has required him to move in with family to provide care and support; and

WHEREAS, in response to their Brother's challenges, Will's "A" Platoon family along with other police family and friends formed "...And All For One" in support of Will; and

WHEREAS, their first endeavor was a sick time donation program for Will in which his Platoon, police family and friends donated their earned sick time to Will through an internal Metropolitan Police program. They sought to extend Will's paycheck and insurance coverage as long as possible; that program continues; and

WHEREAS, their next phase is a trivia night to support Will, particularly during the holiday season. The trivia night is December 20th, 2014 7:00 pm at the St. Louis Police Officer's Association, 3710 Hampton Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize Officer Will Gaddy and we further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
