

RESOLUTION NO. 186
MISSION: ST. LOUIS BEYOND JOBS; JOB
AND LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Beyond Jobs equips men with job training, a community of support and employment opportunities so they can access livable wage job; and

WHEREAS, while less than 5% of the men are working when they enter the Job and Leadership Training program, two months later over 60% are employed prior to completing Phase 2 of the program, nearly 73% are employed; and

WHEREAS in addition to that 91% of the participants receive no new warrants or felonies and Beyond Jobs maintains in contact with 89% of all participants who complete the program; and

WHEREAS, these graduates successfully completed a rigorous eight week Job & Leadership Training program course which entails classes three days a week for a total of 8 hours; 16 hours with an internship provider in addition to meeting with a mentor, job coach and small group leader at least once per week; and

WHEREAS, local businesses, employers and organizations partner with Beyond Jobs to create more opportunity in our city. As our partners create accessible employment options; in addition to providing support and accessibility to available community resources that otherwise would have went untapped.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize this Mission: St. Louis Beyond Jobs; Job and Leadership Training Program graduate and we further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
