

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 203**  
**The 8th annual Fuzzball with the Fuzz Benefit Tournament**

**WHEREAS**, on October 9, 2011, members of the St. Louis Police Department will be hosting the 8th Annual Fuzzball with the Fuzz Benefit Tournament; and

**WHEREAS**, each year this tournament benefits a different person or family in need, or an organization committed to a worthy cause and each year the event has grown; and

**WHEREAS**, the previous seven “Fuzzball with the Fuzz” tournaments have raised a total of more than \$51,000 for their various beneficiaries which have included injured officers, the families of officers killed in the line of duty and as the result of off-duty accidents, ill officers and their family members, members of our community and United States Marines injured in combat overseas; and

**WHEREAS**, This year the tournament has selected two of St. Louis’ finest, Officer Joe Haman and Officer Lucas Roethlisberger. Officer Joe Haman was shot several times during a traffic stop at Grand and Natural Bridge on May 27, 2010. Joe is a former Marine and Iraq War veteran. He was the 5th District’s Police Officer of the Year in 2009. Officer Lucas Roethlisberger was shot in the neck and elbow on October 14, 2010 during a traffic stop at Enright and Bayard. Officer Roethlisberger was named the department’s Overall Officer of the Year for 2010. Both these young men are highly motivated and productive officers. Each of them continues to work very hard to return to duty. They have been without the ability to work overtime and secondary to help provide for their families for an extended period of time; and

**WHEREAS**, This year’s event will be held at Woerner School at 6131 Leona on Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize the many contributions of the 8th Annual Fuzzball with the Fuzz Benefit Tournament to the City of St. Louis and we further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
