WHEREAS, he is the recipient of Combat Infantryman Badge, Bronze Star and the Good Conduct Medal; and

WHEREAS, after being Honorably Discharged from the US Army, he relocated to East St. Louis and joined Truelite M.B. Church; and

WHEREAS, he later joined the Friendship Baptist Church to be with his wife and family. After the passing of his wife, he joined Mt Bethel Baptist Church in 1961.
