

RESOLUTION No. 82
HONORABLE ROBERTA R. HITT

WHEREAS, the Honorable Roberta R. Hitt, Judge of City Court Three, Municipal Division of the Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis, 22nd Judicial Circuit, retired from the bench effective July 9, 2018, having celebrated her seventy-fifth birthday; and

WHEREAS, Judge Hitt was appointed as a provisional judge and as the regular Judge of City Court Three by then Mayor Francis G. Slay and retained in office by Mayor Lyda Krewson; and

WHEREAS, Judge Hitt has served the City of St. Louis in many capacities since beginning her employment with the City in 1988: as regular and provisional judge of St. Louis City Court, in the St. Louis Fire Department, in the St. Louis Agency on Training and Employment, in the Law Department as a prosecuting attorney in the Municipal Division, and as the Manager of Training and Organization Development in the Department of Personnel; and

WHEREAS, Judge Hitt has presided over the housing court docket since being appointed as the judge of City Court Three, and

WHEREAS, Judge Hitt has fulfilled all of those duties with honor and distinction; and

WHEREAS, Judge Hitt is also a member of the NAACP, Urban League of Metropolitan St. Louis, the African-American/Jewish Task Force, and the Missouri Municipal and Associate Circuit Judges Association; and

WHEREAS, Judge Hitt and her husband, George (David) Hitt, have been long time and valuable residents of the Twenty Eighth Ward of the City of St. Louis, and

WHEREAS, we express appreciation to Judge Hitt for the dedicated service she has provided and the contributions she has made to our City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize the Honorable Roberta R. Hitt for her many years of service to the City of St. Louis. We further direct the Clerk of this Board to include a copy of this Resolution in the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a commemorative copy for presentation at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
